Waterdog red wine, a blend of Castelão and Touriga Nacional grape varieties, have a fruity palate with notes of red berries and a touch of wood. Aged for 6 months on French and American Oak. Enjoy it with BBQ, roasts and pasta dishes.

PRODUCTION: 5 000 liters

STORAGE: The bottles should be laid down at a temperature of 12°C and 60% humidity

SHELF LIFE: 4 years after bottling

SERVING SUGGESTIONS: Serve at a temperature of 11°C and consumed at 13°C with BBQ, roasts and pasta dishes

ANALYSES: 13.1% Alcohol | 5.2 g/l Total Acidity | 3.3 pH | less than 9 g/l Residual Sugar

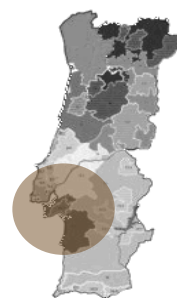
Tasting Notes
